Board members and staff believe the greater Yuma Community would be very interested in designating a portion of US-95 in his memory and honor for such a deserving tribute. This will require coordination with ADOT staff and consultation with the AZ State Board on Geographic and Historic Names. Staff will present further details.

1. Call to Order and Declaration of Votes

Chairman, Frank Sanchez called the meeting to order at 9:01 AM.

The City of Yuma declared votes. City of Yuma, Steve Wilson (3) Erika Peterson (2)

2. <u>Title VI of the Civil Rights ACT of 1964</u>

The YMPO Title VI Nondiscrimination Notice to the Public was read by YMPO IT Manager / Associate Planner Jeffrey Heinrichs.

3. Call to the Public

There were no announcements from the public or TAC members.

Chairman Sanchez addressed the committee, recognizing ADOT Transportation Planner Jennifer Hobert's presence.

4. Approval of Minutes

July 18, 2024, TAC meeting minutes were included with the agenda.

Greg Ellingson, Public Works Director, Town of Wellton motioned to approve the July 18, 2024, minutes. Kelly Fricke, Public Works Director, Yuma County seconded the motion. Motion carried.

5. FY 2026-2050 Long-Range Transportation Plan (LRTP) Update

Vamshi Yellisetty, Kittleson & Associates Consultant, presented this item.

Mr. Yellisetty gave an update on the status of the LRTP topics below:

Task 4: The Draft Existing Conditions Report is still in progress and is anticipated to be completed in late August.

Task 5: Phase 1 Public Outreach ended July 31st; Phase 2 is anticipated to be initiated in late September.

Task 6: A project list for each mode has been created and is currently being worked on. Small group meetings with each jurisdiction will be held to select the correct projects and move forward.

Phase 1 Public Outreach Summary Results: Public outreach was successful. 415 survey responses were received, and Vamshi Yellisetty presented the city's number of survey responses, with Yuma having 200. 245 Online Map Comments were provided as well. Roadway service condition ratings from the public were also presented.

Focus Group Meetings Summary Results: Public deemed roadways busy, congested, busy in the winter, needing attention and unkept roadways when answering questions about our jurisdiction's roadway system. Safety concerns

and rough pavement conditions are also mentioned as challenges in driving on our roadways. Many other focus group questions were presented to the committee with answers from the public.

Mr. Yellisetty stated he would send all jurisdictions a copy of the presentation for their viewing.

6. <u>Possible Regional Project Priority List for 2025</u>

Fernando Villegas, YMPO Senior Transportation Planner, presented this item. Mr. Villegas informed the committee that he received two completed fact sheets: one from Yuma County and the other from the City of Somerton. He is to receive the last one from ADOT the following week. All three projects will be submitted for consideration.

Mr. Villegas informed that the updated fact sheets must be submitted to RTAC by September 16th to be included in the materials and presentations at the Rural Transportation Summit in October. However, the list needs to be approved by the YMPO Executive Board during the next Executive Board meeting.

Last year, three projects were selected: US-95 Wellton-Mohawk to Aberdeen Road, US-95 Pavement Rehabilitation (phase 2) between County 17th St and Avenue D, and Somerton Main Street Improvements

Chairman Sanchez addressed the committee, stating that the committee had previously agreed to leave the same three projects to be submitted and not add any more. He also said they had a bid opening for the Yuma County Project, HWY 95, between County 17 – Ave D, and construction will likely begin in October 2024.

Charles Gutierrez, Public Works Director, City of Somerton, motioned to submit the three projects listed on the Regional Project Priority List for 2025 for presentation to the Executive Board for approval to submit for consideration to RTAC. Arturo Durazo, Tribal Planner, Cocopah Indian Tribe, seconded the motion and passed.

7. Possible New Studies in the Unified Planning Work Program (UPWP)

Mr. Villegas presented this item. Mr. Villegas informed the committee that YMPO staff is preparing the FY2026-27 UPWP and Annual Budget draft with an anticipated completion time frame of March or April of 2025.

Mr. Villegas stated that he would email all members so they can send a possible list of studies they would like to have in the UPWP. Committee members needed no action at this time.

8. 2024 ACEC Arizona Conference on Roads and Streets

Mr. Villegas presented this item by confirming the current registered attendees from the committee and reminding them about the conference dates.

Chairman Sanchez asked if YMPO would extend any unfilled positions to already registered members plus any guests they'd wish to invite.

Mr. Villegas answered that he would confirm if this is possible with the YMPO Executive Director.

9. SMART Program – Possible Regional Letters of Support

Mr. Villegas informed the committee that the YMPO received a Regional Letter of Support request from the City of Yuma for the SMART grant program. Mr. Villegas stated that the proposed Automated Traffic Signal Performance Measure project would synchronize traffic signals in the City of Yuma to promote better traffic flow and improved safety.

Ms. Peterson motioned to recommend the regional letter of support for the City of Yuma for the SMART grant program and ATSPM project to the Executive Board for approval. Steve Wilson, Assistant Director of Engineering, COY (representing Dave Wostenberg) seconded the motion. Motion Carried.

Chairman Sanchez asked Mr. Wilson about the amount of the SMART funds requested. Mr. Wilson answered 1.9 million.

Jennifer Hobert, Regional Planner, ADOT, quickly stated that this was a federal grant, not the state AZSMART fund grant for which the City of Yuma is applying.

10. YMPO Rebranding Update

Jeffrey Heinrichs, YMPO IT Manager/Associate Planner, presented this item. Mr. Heinrichs presented the committee with a new proposed YMPO logo for comments and suggestions. No action was needed, but members provided comments.

Most members expressed that they wanted the same logo and most of the members expressed their dislike for the wording of the "Our Vision" statement that reads, "pollution-free".

Comments were taken into consideration before YMPO presented the information to the Executive Board.

DATE: September 12, 2024.

SUBJECT: Possible New Studies in the Unified Planning Work Program (UPWP).

SUMMARY:

During the August 8, 2024, TAC meeting, members were asked to recommend possible transportation planning studies that YMPO could conduct within the next two years as part of the Unified Planning Work Program (UPWP).

YMPO staff believe that TAC members have a good understanding of the transportation needs in the YMPO region, but members requested staff to suggest some examples. This item is on the agenda to continue the discussion on possible regional transportation plans or studies to be considered as part of the next UPWP.

The UPWP is YMPO's main planning document and is guided by the visions, goals, objectives, and investment framework established in the LRTP. YMPO develops the UPWP every two years and adjusts the budget on an annual basis. Staff are starting to prepare a Draft of the FY 2026-27 YMPO UPWP for consideration and eventual approval by the Executive Board. The possible studies are based firstly on the standard workload targets included in the YMPO By-Laws, and any other local and/or transportation needs that the region may have. The list of possible studies, identified by members of the TAC and Executive Board, are reviewed by staff, and a reasonably detailed summary of each possible study (similar to the mini-DCR for a project being submitted for consideration for funding) is prepared and, following a review of the funds likely to be available for such efforts, a draft list of studies is assembled.

Prior to approval of the Biennial UPWP, the Federal Highway Administration, Federal Transit Administration, and ADOT review and comment on the draft UPWP and this program review is anticipated during March or April 2025.

The following transportation planning studies are part of the current FY 2024-25 UPWP:

- a. The Complete Streets Concept Study;
- b. The FY 2026-2050 Long-Range Transportation Plan Update;
- c. A Roads of Regional Significant Study.

The following studies can also be part of the FY 2026-28 YMPO UPWP, depending on funding availability and whether the documents need to be updated:

a. Comprehensive Safety Action Plan (CSAP) and Demonstration (Safety Street and Roads for All (SS4A) Application);

- A Short-Range Transit Plan Update (this study is normally carried out in conjunction with the Yuma County Intergovernmental Public Transit Authority (YCIPTA)). It is NOT a By-Law mandated study but is regarded as a best practice for 'rural' MPOs by ADOT;
- c. A regional Intelligent Transportation System (ITS) Study and possible location for a regional Traffic Management Center (TMC);
- d. A study of Daily Border-Crossers who work in the YMPO region and their transportation needs (predominantly for the City of San Luis);
- e. A regional map showing bicycle, pedestrian and multi-use facilities (alternative transportation modes) in place and/or programmed;
- f. How and when will the Yuma region attain Transportation Management Area (TMA) status and what the ramifications will be;
- g. A study on the need for a regional sale tax.

Members are requested to add studies to the list, for production of a summary and possible consideration for inclusion in the UPWP, eventual funding and implementation.

Resolution in Support of Renaming – U.S. Route 95 in Honor of the Late Gary Knight

DATE: September 12, 2024.

SUBJECT: Resolution in Support of Renaming U.S. Route 95 in Honor of the Late Gary Knight.

SUMMARY:

As a distinguished Yuma resident, the late City of Yuma Councilmember, and Arizona State Transportation Board Member and Chairman, Gary Knight was a tireless champion for transportation improvements in his region, particularly US Highway 95. Executive Board members and staff believe the Greater Yuma Community would be very interested in designating a portion of US-95 in his memory and honor for such a deserving tribute. This will require coordination with ADOT staff and consultation with the AZ State Board on Geographic and Historic Names.

The AZ State Board on Geographic and Historic Names is statutorily responsible for reviewing application proposals and determining the most appropriate names for places in Arizona.

In statute, commemorative names are subject to a five-year waiting period; however, this only applies to geographic features such as mountains and streams. "Places of historical significance" like US-95 are exempt from this waiting period. Earlier this year there was the renaming of the I-10 Deck Park Tunnel in Phoenix for deceased ADOT engineer Dean Lindsey to the "Dean Lindsey Memorial Tunnel". Dean passed away in 2023, but the Board voted to approve the proposal the same year.

YMPO Staff anticipates coordination with ADOT Southwest District Administrator about State guidelines for the designation of Highway Names for this effort. This initiative was presented to Executive Board members for information and open discussion. Future action will likely include the possible adoption of a YMPO Resolution supporting the renaming of a portion of US Highway 95 in honor of Gary Knight.


