SUBJECT: Rural Regional Priority Project List (YMPO)

SUMMARY:

Regional Project List:

YMPO has been tasked to create a potential list of projects that could be projects that are viable projects for the region based off of a prioritized list is what is being asked to create. This list should be created using the LRTP and any other projects from the local CIPs of agencies possibly in a prioritized ranking and then brought tot the YMPO TAC for further consideration as to a priority and then the list will be recommended to the YMPO Executive Board for approval for the prioritized project list for the region that will serve as the Basic “Yuma MPO Regional Priority Project List.

How quickly we can agree to a list will help determine the viability of putting it forward this session. We could already be past the point of a good probable outcome. If that is the case and developing a list will not cause divisiveness for your regions, then we may still want to go through this exercise and be prepared to start advocating for it well in advance of the start of next 2 session. The budget outlook may not be as strong, but the Arizona economy is still projected to boom the next 2-3 years provided it fully opens back up late in the year. Unlike the recession from last decade, we have fared far better than most of the country. Income tax withholdings have increased during the pandemic in Arizona. There is a strong chance that a sizable surplus will materialize next year as well.

So, the thought is rural AZ partners needs to determine if we want to compile the list of projects and if we want to advocate for this year and/or next? If we do decide to develop the list, we will need to provide some structure such as the number of projects and costs from each region as well as the net totals.

Here is a sample of a project list. The possibility of projects can come from the LRTP, Municipality CIPs, or other developed project lists.

The attached spreadsheet that shows the possibility of projects.

The list will be sent to member agencies and the list will begin to be created. At the next TAC meeting the list will be discussed and subsequent TAC meetings upon a recommendation from the YMPO TAC.

Rebuilding America Infrastructure with Sustainability and Equity (RAISE)

DATE: June 9, 2021

SUBJECT: Rebuilding American Infrastructure with Sustainability and Equity (RAISE)

SUMMARY:

The region has currently only identified one major regional project for possible future funding, the widening of US-95, from Ave 9E to Aberdeen Road (just over 15 miles), from one lane in each direction to two lanes, plus a continuous left turn lane and/or a median. The first segment of that project is already funded with approximately \$28 million State surplus General Fund monies, granted by the State legislature in 2019. The first segment is from Ave 9E to Rifle Range Road (about 3 miles) and the construction phase is expected to go to bid on May 20, 2021.

For the past two years, ADOT has submitted for BUILD Grants to help continue the construction of the remaining 12-plus miles through Aberdeen Road, but has been unsuccessful. Last year, YMPO provided additional support for the ADOT application. This year, ADOT has encouraged YMPO to submit an application for possible RAISE funding for the next segment of US-95 improvements and YMPO staff is putting together a scope of work for this Grant Application, which is due by July 12, 2021.

YMPO has been notified by the City of San Luis that the city is going to be submitting a RAISE Application to FHWA. With the region developing a priority list this will allow the mpo to successfully have the ability to address the application process for Letters of Support and the priority of projects for regional consideration. As the MPO has the ability to support many projects in the region, a list of a prioritized list of past regional projects, current projects, and finally future possible projects would be the easiest, safest, and most reliable method for mpo staff (Present & Future Staff) and boards to successfully support projects in the region.

Currently, YMPO has retained a consultant to complete the RAISE Application on behalf of the region on the US 95 from Rifle Range Road to Wellton/Mohawk Canal for \$18 Million with an 80/20% Match, and there is approximately 5-7 million for this match.

PUBLIC INPUT:

There has been no public input on this subject, to date.

TECHNICAL & POLICY IMPLICATIONS:

TECHNICAL: YMPO has sufficient local funds for this regional effort. However, the timeframe is extremely short.

POLICY: There are no policy implications regarding this effort, as the funds are likely to be local funds for the regional application for the RAISE for the US 95 project. Similar to utilizing local funds for acquiring and upgrading the new YMPO office, this expenditure of funds is for a fully regional priority. It is possible that an application for RAISE funds might conflict with an application from a YMPO member agency.

ACTION NEEDED:

This item is in need of a determination and motion of how the MPO moves forward with the current RAISE options with the application process of the ranking of projects.

PRIOR BOARD/COMMITTEE ACTIONS:

From the Executive Board on May 27, 2021

Authorized the Executive Director to negotiate and award a contract for consultant services to apply for a RAISE Grant.
