 -  **Application Process – Fair Distribution;**
 -  **Implementation Process.**

Types of Federal Funds and Amounts

In general, there are five different types of federal funds available for programming in the YMPO region:

- **YMPO Programmable Federal Funds;**
- **ADOT Programmable Federal Funds;**
- **Grant Funds;**
- **Non-Title 23 Federal Funds;**
- **Other Lesser-Used Federal Highway Funds.**

Application Process – Fair Distribution

The application process depends on the funds concerned:

- **YMPO funds – Mini-DCR, TAC recommends, Board approves;**
- **ADOT – Varies based on fund type;**
- **Grant Funds – Open Season ?;**
- **Non-Title 23 Funds – Case by Case basis;**
- **Lesser-Used Funds – Case by Case basis.**

Implementation Process

The implementation process may vary depending on funds concerned:

- Inclusion in TIP;
- Initiation Packet with ADOT;
- Project Development Phases included in TIP;
- IGA/JPA Requirements;
- Payment of Local Match, and Authorization of Federal funds;
- Bid and Construction and Close Out Process.

The Request for Proposals will probably be advertised within the next six months :

- **Consultation on Final Scope of Work;**
- **Advertisement for Consultant and/or Team;**
- **Schedule for Completion;**
- **Review and Comment by TAC and/or Board;**
- **Policy for Programming Federal Funds in the YMPO TIP.**
